It's about rural communities, who were the masters of upcycling before it ever became fashionable; Making and mending, reusing and repairing, wellbeing, food and looking to nature for home grown remedies were all central parts of countryside living. Our two-day Spring Weekender will be an opportunity for visitors to learn how to bring a new lease of life to their possessions, hear from experts, uncover the path to sustainable living and have a go at their own projects.

The Weald & Downland Museum have asked me to invite all sheds in the Southern Men's Shed Network to exhibit their Shed and some of its crafts.

They are looking to hire some form of covered bays which would be located in their event field (each bay would measure approx. 3.3 metres in size), where you could demonstrate, exhibit, market yourselves and sell any items.
