


Workshop Layout Discussion



 - Accessible washroom
 - Workshop 7m by 4m internal

 - What benches should we have and where (fixed or movable)
 - What power tools do we need initially and in the future
 - Which tools should be fixed and which moveable/stored for occasional use.
 - Also advice on lighting, heating etc
- What are the essentials and what are 'nice to have'?
- What mistakes should we not make? What should we avoid?
