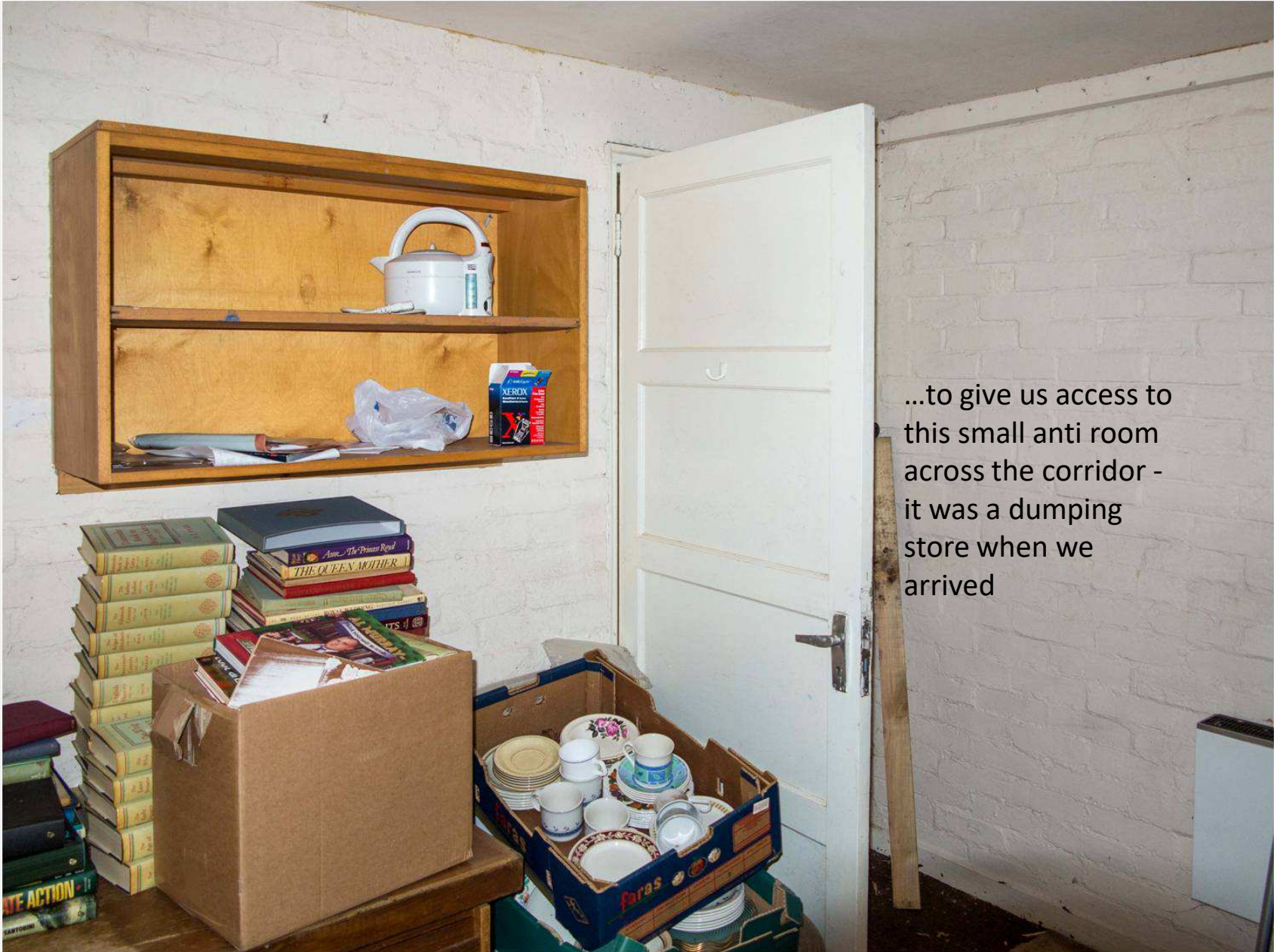

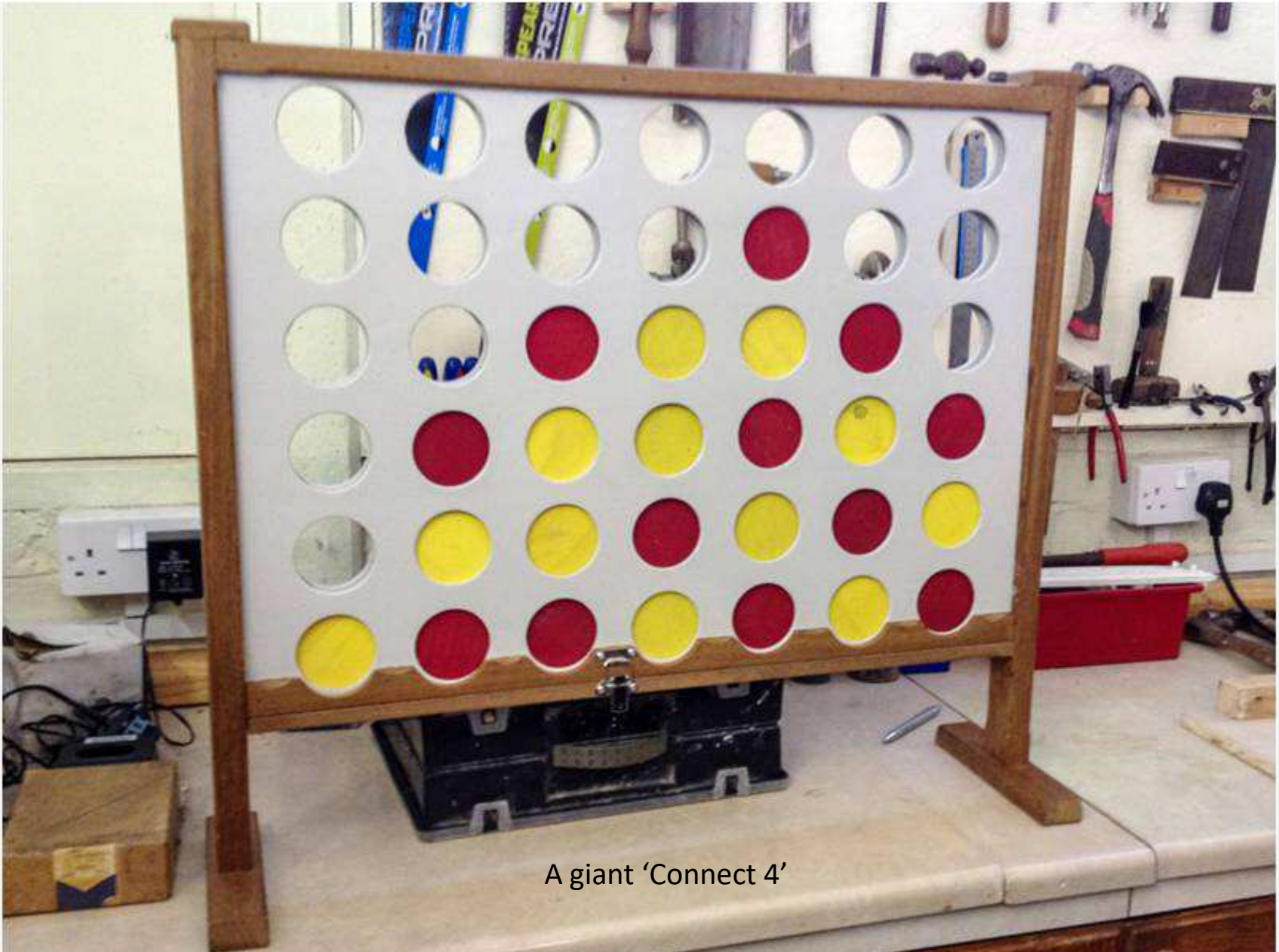




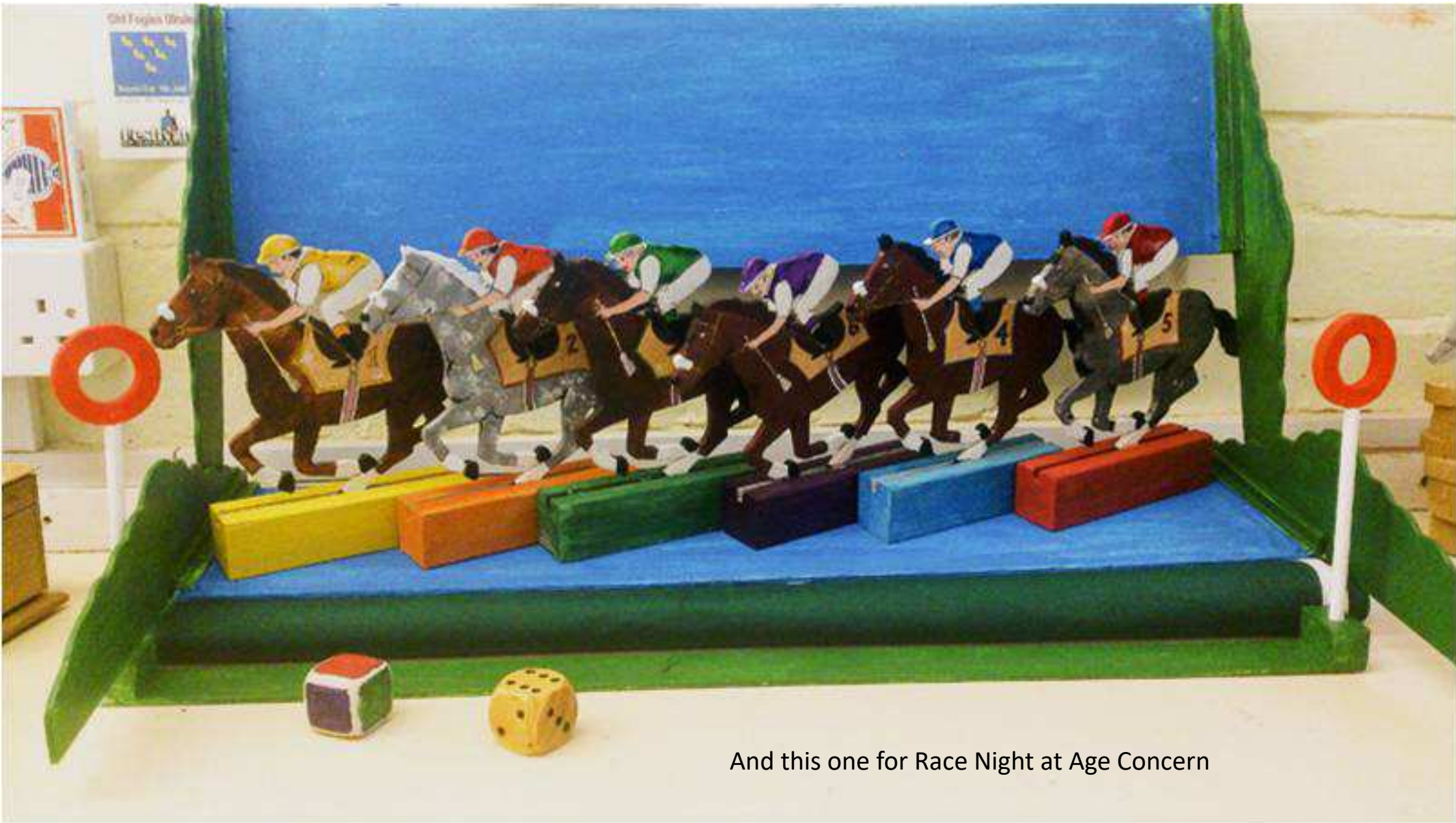

The roof's on

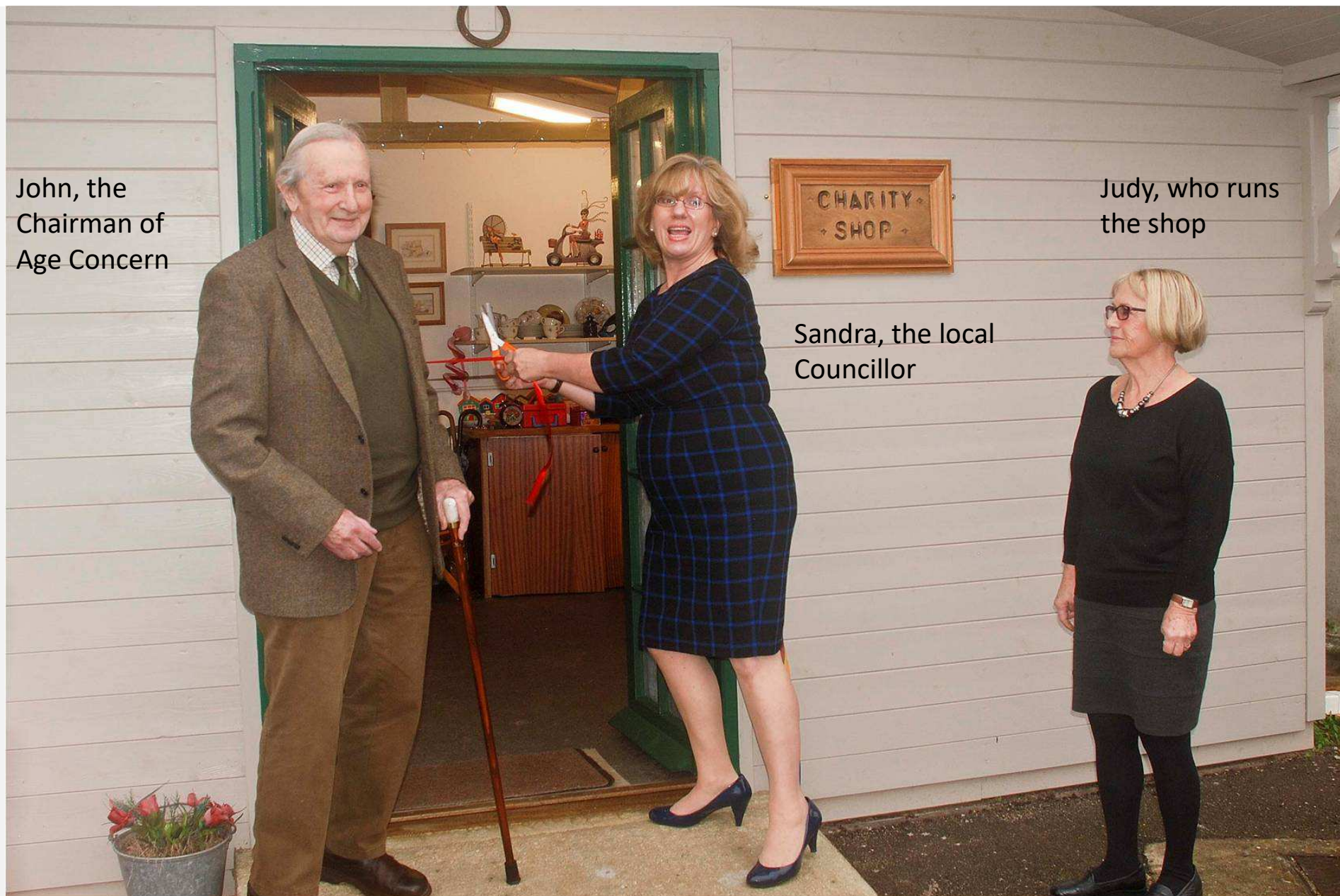
